REMINDERS

Tuition payments are due on the 1st of each month.

- The first day for M-F & T/TH students is September 7th.
- The first day for M/W/F Students is September 8th.
- The school day starts at 8:30am. All students should be here by 8:45 am at the *latest*.
- ➤ Before Care starts at 7:15 am. **You must be registered for before care for early drop off.

NOTE: Students must remain with parents at all times during drop off and pick up. Children are not permitted to roam the building without an adult. This is a safety issue.

Morning drop off:

- Children are not permitted to be dropped off eating breakfast. Students may not bring breakfast into class. This is a safety issue regarding students with allergies. Students will be asked to wait in the with parents until breakfast is finished.
- All students must be dropped off and settled in their classes no later than 8:45 am. Our school day starts promptly at 9:00 am. It is very distracting to the other students when students arrive late. Late students will not be permitted to enter the classroom during instruction time. It is not fair to the other students who are engaged in their lessons.
- Students are not permitted to be dropped off earlier than their contracted drop off time. Our staff ratio does not allow for early drop offs. If you arrive earlier than your specified time, you will be asked to wait in the foyer with your child until your drop off time.

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DROP OFF/PICK UP PROCEDURES

*We will continue to follow our outside Drop Off/Pick Up procedures. Please visit out website for details.

Before Care begins at 7:15am, school starts at 8:30am. Pick up for basic school day is at 12:30pm. Aftercare pick up times are 2:30, 3:30, 4:30 and 5:15pm.

Please be sure to sign in and out each day. There will be no admittance after 8:45 unless the office has been <u>notified and</u> approved.

- If your scheduled drop off time is 7:15 am, you will be dropping off at the main door. Parents must park in the lot and walk their children and their belongings to the door and ring the bell.
- If your drop off time is 8:30AM, you will be dropping your child off at their classroom door. Parents must escort children and their belongings to their classroom doors.
- PreK and 3yr students will use the Lyceum Ave. entrance doors.
- Toddlers, 1yr and 2yr students will use the last door in the parking lot that opens directly into the 2yr classroom.

STUDENT SAFETY

- Please be cautious when entering or leaving the parking lot...little feet travel here.
- Please do not allow access to anyone you do not know into the building. Do not hold doors open. Make sure doors are closed behind you.

PARKING:

All vehicles must **enter** through Lyceum Avenue side only and **exit** through Mitchell Street side only. This is for the safety of our students. Please know that this request is **not optional**. We ask for your consideration and cooperation. Please be mindful that little feet travel in the parking lot. Please go slowly. If you are parking along side of the building, please pull up as close to the building as possible so that other cars may get through.

ACTIVITIES

During registration, Four Seasons School collected an activity fee from each child. We have exciting activities planned for each month. Please ask your teachers if you have any questions about this or upcoming events.

It is important to keep your child home when they are sick. If your child is sent home sick, they may not return to school until they have been **symptom free** from the last occurrence for 48 hours.

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SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Ones

- AM & PM milk cups (spill proof) clearly labelled *If your child drinks milk/if your child no longer drinks milk water will be served.
 - Refillable water bottle daily, clearly labelled.
- Lunches cannot be warmed up. Please send items that are cut and ready to serve.
 - Please pack a clean bib in lunch box daily.
- •Diaper cream with medical protocol form in a Ziploc bag, clearly labelled.
 - 3 changes of clothes clearly labeled
 - Diapers- about 25
 - Wipes- 2 packs

Twos

- A labeled, full water bottle daily
- Lunches cannot be warmed up. Please send items that are cut and ready to serve.
- Diaper cream with medical protocol form in a Ziploc bag, clearly labelled.
- A complete change of clothing in a large Ziploc bag. Child's name on the bag, please.
 - An extra pair of shoes. (labeled)
 - Diapers- about 25 * no pull-ups please!
 - Wipes- 2 packs

Threes

- A labeled, full water bottle daily
- Lunches cannot be warmed up. Please send items that are cut and ready to serve.
- Diaper cream with medical protocol form in a Ziploc bag, clearly abelled
- 2 sets of clothing in a large Ziploc bag. Child's name on the bag, please.
 - An extra pair of shoes. (labeled)
 - One pack of assorted color dry erase markers
 - · One pack of glue sticks
 - Plastic spoons
 - · One plastic folder
 - One individual photo of child
 - One family photo

PreK

- A labeled, full water bottle daily
- Lunches cannot be warmed up. Please send items that are cut and ready to serve.

 - A small flashlight (labeled)
 - · One pack of highlighters
 - Coffee filters
 - Plain paper plates
